LOCAL FAMILY

- We assist our visitors from their arrival point in the city of Puerto Maldonado, whether from the airport or the bus station.
- Shiringa Camp awaits you. A new camping lodge located in the territory of the native community Infierno, just 45 minutes by car from the city and managed by a native family from the same community.
- We will have our first activity to acclimatize to the climate of the Peruvian jungle, taking an interpretive walk through our primary forest where the flora and fauna will be appreciated.

Tres Chimbadas Lake

We wake up very early in the morning and after breakfast we head along the Tambopata River for about 2 hours, and then walk through the jungle for about 30 minutes, sail on the lake on a catamaran with the possibility of observing the family of giant otters that live in this lake, as well as the diversity of fauna, such as cormorants, king-fishers, hoatzin and black caimans.

- After lunch, we tour the community to learn about the history of the native community, belonging to the Takana's family, dominant of the Ese'eja dialect. Likewise, they will teach us the different uses that the artisans give to the variety of seeds, fruits, tree barks and lianas.
- As night falls, we delve into the mysteries that the jungle offers us, taking a night walk in search of nocturnal fauna, mainly insects, amphibians and reptiles.

Lets live with the locals

- After breakfast, we will visit the local farms, where the people carry out agricultural activities, learning about the various products (fruits, vegetables, grains, etc.) that they work every day and also the techniques they use for their production.
- After having had a hot morning, we will navigate for around 30 minutes in a canoe through the "Chonta" ravine, where we will enjoy its refreshing waters and the cool breeze under the trees while we paddle, we will also spot the different species that can be found during the tour.



- We hope you enjoyed your stay with us, we return to the city so you can continue with yo your next destination.
